Dear Stephen Moeller,

The Georgia Department of Public Health, Environmental Health Section, has received your product information concerning the Biomaze<sup>TM</sup> equipment manufactured by RioVation, Inc. We have concluded your product, if used as demonstrated in your installation manual, will cause no harm to existing systems. We will, therefore, consider your product an additive to existing on-site sewage management systems.

If RioVation choses to market the Biomaze<sup>TM</sup> system as an additive in Georgia, the Department of Public Health requests the following protocol to be followed:

- For record keeping, notification of all Biomaze<sup>™</sup> system installations shall be provided to the local county health department including property owner name, address, phone number, and date of installation.
- 2) Installation of the Biomaze<sup>TM</sup> system shall be performed by a DPH certified septic tank contractor, authorized and trained by RioVation on installation procedures.
- 3) Any alterations and/or additions to the components of a septic tank shall be permitted and inspected by the local county health department. This includes, but is not limited to: installation of risers, alterations to the inlet tee and/or conveyance piping.
